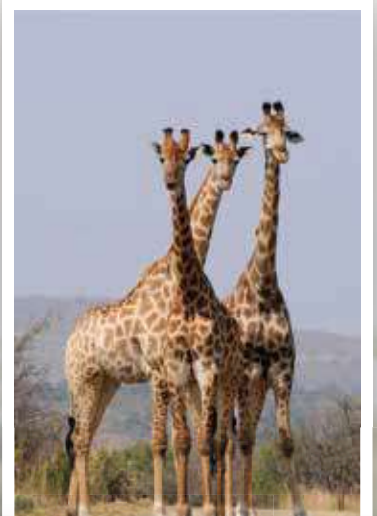

DAY 1: ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at J.K.I.A you will be met and transferred for an overnight at Hilton Garden inn - Bed and breakfast

DAY 02: NAIROBI - SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE:

After breakfast, pick up at the city hotel and proceed to the Northern frontier district via Isiolo to Samburu National Reserve. Arrive in time for lunch at the Lodge. Late afternoon game viewing drives. The reserve is rich in wildlife with fame for abundance in rare northern specialist species such as the Grevy Zebra, Somali Ostrich, Reticulated Giraffe, Gerenuk and the Beisa Oryx (Also referred to as Samburu Special). The reserve is also popular with a minimum of 900 elephants. Large predators such as the Lion, Leopard and Cheetah are an important attraction. Dinner and overnight at the lodge/camp



DAY 03: SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE:

Early morning and afternoon game viewing around a peaceful Samburu reserve with variety of wildlife e.g., gerenuk, Oryx and reticulated giraffe one can also see the famous lioness 'kamunyak' known for adopting Oryx calves, option of a full day game drive with lunch can be organized. Dinner and overnight at the lodge /camp



DAY 04: SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE - OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY:

After breakfast depart and drive past Mt Kenya towards Nanyuki. Enter Ol Pejeta conservancy and have a game drive en route towards the Sweet Waters Camp arriving in time for lunch. The conservancy safeguard vulnerable species including black rhino and chimpanzees. Other vulnerable or endangered species that live here include elephant, African wild dog, cheetah, lion, leopard, hippo, Grevy's zebra and the locally threatened Jackson's hartebeest. 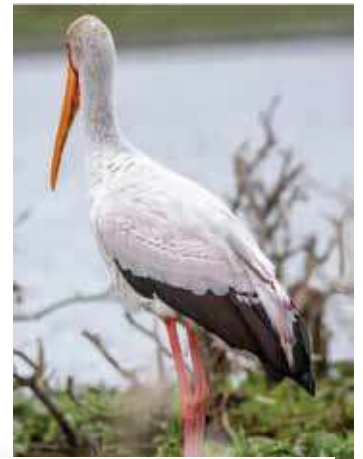

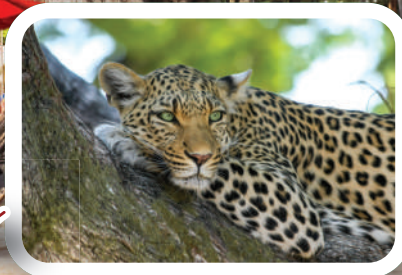
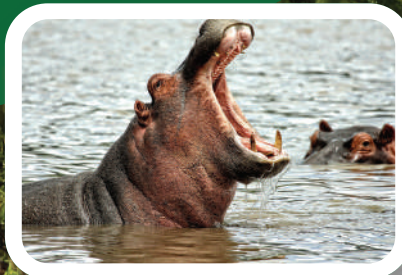
